Joe Fagnani announced that the Service Paws organization will hold their golf outing next Thursday, July 11 at Park Hills. Golfers are needed.

Program;

President Phil introduced Bob VanKirk who with his wife Diana run 4 Seasons Farm in Tyrone. They specialize in registered Red Devon cattle. The farm has two hundred beef herd of Red Devon and crossbred cattle. Bob and Diana market 100% grassfed beef. Bob also serves as the President of Red Devon USA. Red Devon cattle thrive on grass. They also crossbreed well. Bob mentioned that most people are confused about the different types of beef. In the USA, it is legal to put on labels of foreign beef that it is a product of the USA because the beef is packaged in the USA. He also mentioned that beef no longer needs to be labeled.

Grassfed beef has less fat. It is also more heart healthy. There is no need to till the pastures in which the cattle graze and this practice is good for conservation.

The cattle graze for eight months on five different farms in this area.

Bob reported that the World Red Devon Conference participants visited his farm last year. In October, the Keystone Internal Livestock Conference will be held in Harrisburg, which attracts some 4,000 visitors.

4 Seasons Farm sells it beef by word-of-mouth. Bob provided his business cards to the Rotarians.

Fred Thursfield returned this week from surgery and it was nice to have him back and looking so good.
