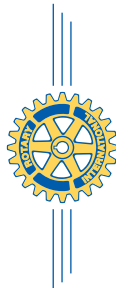

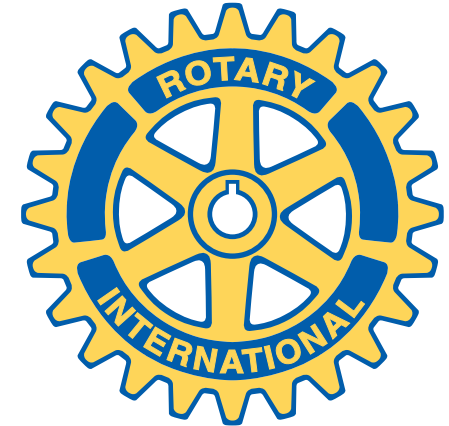

center is designed to assess children who are victims of abuse, physical, sexual and emotional, as well as, children who have witnessed abuse, have been exposed to pornography or trafficking. She set the stage by having us remember something that frightened us like being called to the principal's office and a location that made us uncomfortable. Imagine telling your deepest concerns to a stranger in that kind of a setting. The Center for Child Justice has three fulltime staff and one contracted individual to assist with assessments. It is designed to put parents and children at ease. Interviews of children are done behind two way glass with Children & Youth, police, district attorneys and other necessary players present and observing while the advocate meets with the child. A cd is provided to these parties for prosecution of the perpetrator. The center does not keep copies. Since opening in September of 2017, the center has served 289 children ranging from age 3-18.
