Membership in a Rotary Club is by invitation only to business, professional, community, and institutional leaders in the community.

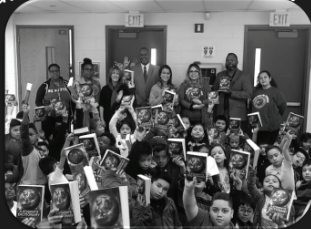
Each Rotarian holds a classification, representing the business' activities or service to society, such as banking, retail service, etc.

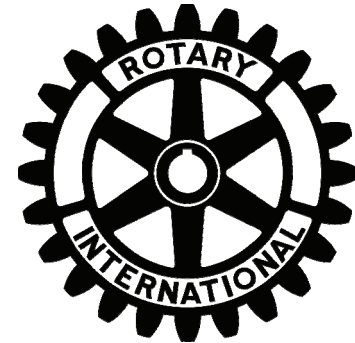
