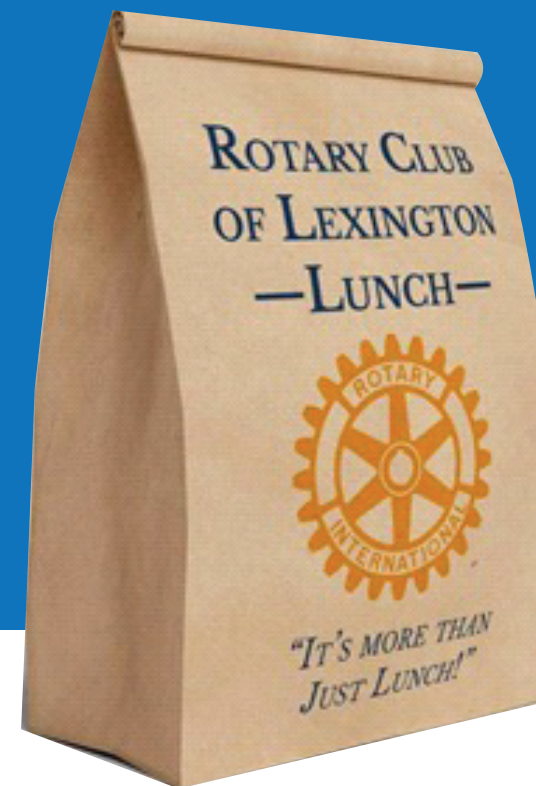

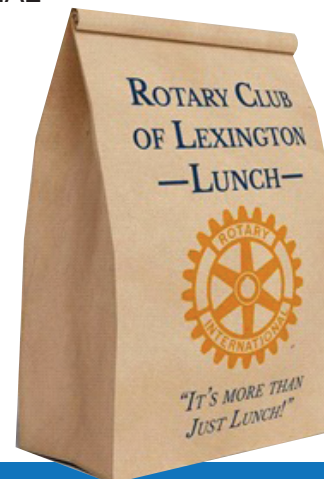
Currently we have 26 members and are looking for committed, ethical, and hard-working members to join our club.
