

Williamsburg Rotary Club Foundation Grant Program

The Williamsburg Rotary Foundation (WRF) was formed in 1997 as a 501(c)(3) philanthropic arm of the Rotary Club of Williamsburg. Every year the Foundation accepts grant applications beginning in July and ending on November 30th. If approved, the awards are made in April of the following year.

In order to qualify, the applicant must be a charitable, religious, educational and/or scientific non-profit organization located in the greater Williamsburg area that serves the people of Williamsburg, James City County, or the Bruton District of York County.

The Foundation does not award grants to organizations that have their own foundations such as the United Way, Red Cross, Salvation Army, or the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation.

The Foundation requests that each applicant be sponsored by a member of our club. If the applicant does not have a sponsor, contact the president of the Williamsburg Rotary Foundation who will assist in finding one.
