

Williamsburg Rotary Club Foundation Grant Program

The Williamsburg Rotary Foundation (WRF) was formed in 1997 as a 501(c) (3) philanthropic arm of the Rotary Club of Williamsburg. Every year we accept grant applications beginning in July and ending on November 15th. If approved, the awards are made in April of the following year. In order to qualify, the applicant must be a charitable, religious, educational and/or scientific non-profit organization located in the greater Williamsburg area that serves the people of Williamsburg, James City County, or the Bruton District of York County. We don't award grants to organizations that have their own foundations such as the United Way, Red Cross, Salvation Army, or the Williamsburg Foundation. Grant applications can be found on our website along with the most recent contact information for submitting the form. We do request that each applicant be sponsored by a member of our club. If you don't have a sponsor, contact the president-elect to see if he can find one for you.
