An update from Colleen Bonadonna, District Polio Plus Chair:

- -We have not had any cases of the wild polio year to date.
- -Last week there were six cases of circulating Vaccine Derived Polio type 2 in the Democratic Republic of Congo and one case in Burundi resulting from the new novel vaccine.
- -The novel vaccine has been distributed to over 600 million children since March 2021 and these are the first cases from this vaccine.
- -The Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI) has put out a press release https://polioeradication.org/gpeimedia-centre/.
- -I am traveling to Rotary International in Evanston, this weekend and will learn more about Rotary's response. On my return next week, I will send an update to all the clubs.


