

ROTARY PROJECT: TURNING WINE BOTTLES BACK INTO SAND

Though glass is derived from a naturally occurring material, once that substance is transformed into bottles, it is hardly a boon to the environment. Each year in the U.S., people throw away some 8 million tons of glass, a bulky part of landfills that can last ages. The Environmental Protection Agency reports that only about a third of glass that Americans buy gets recycled. **The Rotary Club of Chelan, Washington**, found an opportunity to mine some of that glass out of the waste stream. The club partnered with local agencies and businesses to buy a glass pulverizing machine which turns used bottles and broken glass back into sand that can be used in gardening, landscaping, playgrounds, and biological water filter projects.

THIS WEEK IN HISTORY

Dec.11.1978. Nearly \$6 million in cash and jewels was stolen from the air cargo building of the German airline <u>Lufthansa</u> at John F. Kennedy International Airport in <u>New York City</u>; at the time, the <u>Lufthansa heist</u>, as it became known, was the largest-ever cash theft in the United States.

Dec.10.1962. The British historical film <u>Lawrence of Arabia</u>, which starred <u>Peter O'Toole</u>, had its world premiere; it became one of the most celebrated epics in the history of cinema.

Dec.9.1965. The animated special *A Charlie Brown Christmas*, featuring characters from <u>Charles Schulz</u>'s popular <u>Peanuts comic strip</u>, first aired on American television, and it became a holiday classic.
