AFE serves the Northeastern region of the United States, and for destinations beyond, they link with other volunteer pilot organizations. *Anyone who requests a flight must be medically stable, able to board an aircraft, and fly in a small non-pressurized aircraft.* Volunteer pilots use their own aircraft to fly patients to their destinations. These men and women pay for all expenses for each mission they fly. Most AFE patients require air transportation numerous times over several years for treatment of and follow-up for their conditions.
