Rotary Moment Nov 16. Jack explained the 4 categories of Foundation Awards from District 7600 given to Clubs annually. They are (a) Total Per Capita Giving: with a goal of \$250 per member (b)-100% Foundation Giving: every member contributes to at least one fund, with the club average to all funds at least \$100 per capita (c)-100% Every Rotarian Every Year: at least \$25 per member to the Annual Fund, and at least \$100 per capita to the Annual Fund (d) Polio Eradication: with a goal of \$1,500 per c

INTERNATIONAL MEN'S DAY (IMD) is a global holiday celebrated annually on November 19th to recognize and celebrate the cultural, political, and socioeconomic achievements of men. The objectives of celebrating an International Men's Day are set out in 'All The Six Pillars of International Men's Day'.^[1] It is an occasion to celebrate boys' and men's lives, achievements and contributions, in particular for their contributions to nation, union, society, community, family, marriage, and childcare. The broader and ultimate aim of the event is to promote basic awareness towards men's issues.^[2]

THANKSGIVING is a national [holiday](#) celebrated on various dates in the [United States](#), [Canada](#), [Grenada](#), [Saint Lucia](#), and [Liberia](#). It began as a day of giving thanks for the blessing of the [harvest](#) and of the preceding year. Similarly named festival holidays occur in Germany and Japan. Thanksgiving is celebrated on the [second Monday of October](#) in Canada and on the [fourth Thursday of November](#) in the United States and around the same part of the year in other places. Although Thanksgiving has historical roots in religious and cultural traditions, it has long been celebrated as a [secular](#) holiday as well.
