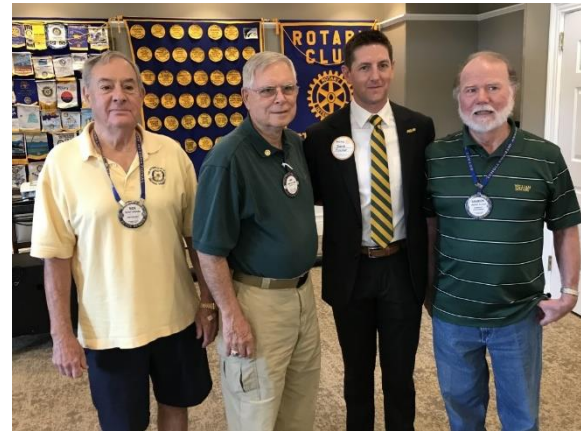

WORLD POLIO DAY OCT 24, 2022

"A healthier future for mothers and children", will be held virtually and in-person on 21-22 October in Geneva, Switzerland. The event will highlight the status of polio eradication and address the potential for community-based solutions that go beyond immunizations to enhance the health of mothers and their children.

Following the announcement of Rotary's **pledge of an additional US\$150 million** toward future polio eradication efforts, Rotary International President Jennifer Jones will join Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, director-general of the World Health Organization (WHO) in discussing the state of polio eradication and its broader relevance to global health. Register now to attend in-person. **(Registration not required to take part virtually)**

The recent detections of the poliovirus in New York and UK have increased awareness of the disease's continued threat. Earlier this year, an unvaccinated man in New York was paralyzed and poliovirus was detected in sewage in London. The moment presents an opportunity to highlight the importance of vaccinations as the only form of protection against polio and many other diseases.
