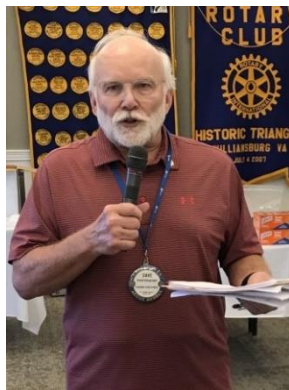

Sep.28.1781. The [Siege of Yorktown](#) began, eventually leading on October 19 to the British surrender by General [Lord Cornwallis](#) and the end of the [American Revolution](#).

Sep.28.1920.In what became known as the [Sox Scandal](#), eight members of the [Chicago White Sox](#) baseball team were indicted by a grand jury on charges that they had thrown the 1919 [World Series](#) to the [Cincinnati Reds](#) in return for a bribe.
