## Petersburg Rotary Clubs

The Rotary Club of Petersburg, chartered in 1917, began its extension program in 1924 with a new chapter in Hopewell, followed by Blackstone (1925), South Hill (1928), Emporia (1946), Colonial Heights, (1955), and Petersburg (Breakfast) (1987). The Club has awarded scholarships to area youth attending local colleges for 57 years. This year, five \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded to deserving students. The club has supported many community and global projects with proceeds from the golf tournament, Brunswick stew and peanut fund raisers, to include the Petersburg Library, the Petersburg Family YMCA, the Jackson-Feild Home, the Lee Park Pavilion, the Pocahontas Island Park, as well as Rotary global grants focused on clean water projects and medical equipment for hospitals. Annually, our club supports Rotary International's goal to eradicate polio throughout the world.

Since 1987 the Petersburg (Breakfast) Rotary Club has been supporting the Tri-Cities and surrounding area through organizations such as the Petersburg Family YMCA, Jackson-Feild Home, Boys and Girls Club of Petersburg, Friends of the Lower Appomattox River, and the Petersburg Library. The Club has also spearheaded service projects in the community, such as playground installations, beautification initiatives, and back-to-school programs. The Club supports Rotary International in its five areas of focus: Promoting Peace, Fighting Disease, Providing Clean Water, Sanitation and Hygiene, Saving Mothers and Children, Supporting Education, and Growing Local Economies.

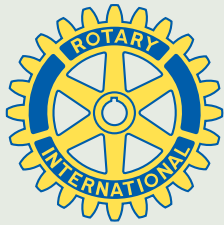
