Discussions were held with the --I believe-- Directors of the Albemarle Club and contact was made with District. A organizing committee was formed with Buddy Smith as the District Gov. Rep and chair. I cannot remember who was on the committee but I believe in addition to Buddy and me, there was Ken Neathery and Marshall Pryor and probably a member from the the Charlottesville and Albemarle clubs.

The committee met several times and a prospective name was chosen--that is another story, for another time--, and prospective membership names were submitted. Buddy asked me if I would serve as Charter President and assist with forming the officer and committee list. I agreed and the rest is history. The first two Presidents were set. The first five were:

- 2. Ken Neathery
- 3. Jim Kennan who switched places with Harold Qwright due to construction at Harold's TV station
- 4. Harold Wright
- 5. Marshall Pryor

There was no grand plan in place that the first three presidents were "HOKIES"
