McLEAN ROTARY CHOCOLATE FESTIVAL 2020 SPONSORSHIP SOLICITATION GUIDELINES


In an effort order to improve the results of our sponsorship solicitation efforts and to better utilize the physical improvements of the recently renovated McLean Community Center the Chocolate Festival Committee is introducing 9 different levels of sponsorship. The following guidelines help explain how to sell those new sponsorship levels:

- 1. Be sure to explain that revenues from these sponsorships and the Chocolate Festival are used to support many local and international charities through the McLean Rotary Foundation (a tax exempt 501(c)3 non-profit Virginia corporation).
- The Chocolate Supreme and Chocolate Jubilee levels are intended for major sponsors. The committee has targeted and will directly approach certain McLean companies for these sponsorships.
- 3. Our previously popular vinyl banner signs have proven difficult to install and even more difficult to be seen by attendees. Accordingly, we are now switching to paper banner signs. There are 2 sizes: Chocolate Sundae (4' X 4') and Chocolate Smoothie (4' X 2'). These banner signs will be taped to the interior glass lining the courtyard, can be read on both sides, and will be much more visible to patrons as they walk through the hallways.
- 4. We will be using an 11" X 14" program map to help attendees locate the various venues they can enjoy. On the flip side we will be selling logo space (previously business cards) sponsorships at 2 levels: Chocolate Mousse = 2 spaces; Chocolate Chip = 1 space.
- 5. The new Chocolate Shake level is for sponsors donating items to the Festival Marketplace.
- 6. The Friend of Rotary allows sponsoring companies to have an exhibit table promoting their business in the Stedman Room adjacent to the chocolate vendors. We haven't decided for sure to use this room for non-chocolate companies (it depends on how many chocolate vendors we have) but you can gauge their interest in having an exhibitor space and we can get back to them in December.
- 7. Finally, we have the "Proud Sponsor" flyer for local businesses who are unable to support the Chocolate Festival at the higher sponsorship levels, but still would like to show their support for the Festival. Please try this one when all else has failed.
- 8. We are also circulating a prospect signup sheet listing 29 local companies that have not been sponsors in the past, but we would like to be approached for sponsorships now. Please sign up to approach at least one of these listed companies and make this festival a great success.
- 9. We have prepared a packet for you to use when you approach a potential sponsor. We hope it will facilitate your presentation and make it easier for you to obtain a positive outcome.





McLean Chocolate Festival


- Twenty or more vendors sell candy, cookies, cupcakes, ice cream and other chocolate treats.
- American Heritage, a Mars, Incorporated brand based in Williamsburg, Virginia, demonstrates eighteenth-century chocolate making.
- Local high school students lead pre-schoolers in chocolate-themed games and perform face painting.
- Instrumental and vocal performers give half hour concerts throughout the day
- Patrons shop at a Marketplace selling items and gift certificates to local establishments.
- Patrons buy raffle tickets to win chocolate-themed gift baskets or a chocolate pearl necklace.


