Annual Report Fiscal Year ending 30 June 2015

Fiscal year 2015 was another outstanding year for your Foundation. The Foundation endowment invested funds grew to \$303,966, an increase of \$12,656 (a 4.34% return) over the previous year versus an increase of \$33,067 (12.8% return) for the previous fiscal year. In addition, the Foundation has a yearend Current fund balance (checking account and money market fund) of \$15,714.37, of which all but \$839.30 is committed for checks written but not cleared plus approved project funding carried over into the new Rotary year (\$5,000 for Partner for Surgery). Foundation expenses for the fiscal year were \$90.19.

During this past year the Foundation approved and funded 24 different projects (see attached exhibit A, includes pass-through projects) for a total of \$93,195 in funding versus 25 projects and \$86,943 for the previous fiscal year. Out of the \$93,195 amount, \$36,815 was pass-through designated funding for Stop Hunger Now and Shelter Box, and \$2,000 came from a District Grant for Rebuilding Together. The Club's other major projects approved and funded by the Foundation Board were High School Graduate Scholarships towards continuing college level education (\$9,300); Timber Lane Elementary School Reading Program (\$4,000); Michelo (\$5,000); and Lewinsville Retirement Residences (\$3,500).

The sources of income for the Foundation received from the Club consisted of the following:

The Foundation Board considers the recommended projects at the regular Board meetings and decides which projects are approved for funding as well as the final amounts funded. The Foundation will continue its efforts to increase contributions in support of the endowment and for current use and designated funds.

The McLean Rotary Foundation funding is primarily focused upon benefiting the local community. Current Use funds are used as the members request with the approval of the Foundation Board. We urge all members to keep the Foundation in mind as you consider your charitable giving in the coming year.
