Escola Estrela do Mar (the Starfish School), founded in November 2004, provides free, all-day, complete education to 25 children, ages 3-7 in the impoverished village of Bebedouro, city of Maceio, state of Alagoas, Brazil. The primary goal of the school is to provide the best, most complete education possible, which means focusing on academics, while strongly emphasizing health and personal development. David Leiner is a D.C. native who went to Maceio about 3 years ago. While in Maceio, **David** volunteered in the community, as he has in Washington (Boys & Girls Clubs, JCC, YMCA, D.C. Cares, etc). His experience in a very corrupt charity which was supposed to be helping poor children was very upsetting. He remebered the Starfish Story, the moral of which is to focus on what is within your means to accomplish. That led **David** Leiner to create Escola Estrela do Mar.
