ROTARY'S *PolioPlus* GLOBAL EFFORT

1. "By the time the world is certified polio-free, Rotary's contributions to the global polio eradication effort will be **nearly US\$650 million**.
2. Since 1988, **5 million people**, who otherwise would be paralyzed with polio, are now walking because of Rotary efforts.
3. Rotary and its global partners vaccinated over **2 billion children** in 2005.
4. More than **1 million** Rotarians worldwide have contributed toward polio eradication efforts.
