ROTARY'S PolioPlus GLOBAL EFFORT

- "By the time the world is certified polio-free, Rotary's contributions to the global polio eradication effort will be nearly US\$650 million.
- 2. Since 1988, **5 million people**, who otherwise would be paralyzed with polio, are now walking because of Rotary efforts.
- 3. Rotary and its global partners vaccinated over 2 billion children in 2005.
- 4. More than **1 million** Rotarians worldwide have contributed toward polio eradication efforts.
