Last Meeting

Scott Mills gave an update of the works of the Rotary Foundation. Fifty percent of all Rotarian dues come back to the district; the other fifty percent is used to fund international projects. The administration of the foundation is funded entirely from contributions by individual Rotarians. The Future Visions Plan will begin in FY 2014 and will allow each district to fund up to 50% of its funds on community projects, up from a current ceiling of 20%. Last year District 7610 donated \$622,000 to the foundation, making it third among US clubs and 8th worldwide. McLean was the first club to exceed \$500,000 in all-time giving, two-thirds of which was donated in the last six years
