- John Rosenbaum reminded us that Saturday, May 19th is McLean Day. Signup sheets for volunteers were distributed and will continue to be passed around at upcoming meetings...
- Vance Zavela announced that the McLean District Police Station is collecting any unused prescription drugs for safe handling
- Heather Schoppe was happy to announce that Dominic Alexander and Steve Richardson had filled upcoming volunteer slots at Alternative House. Additional volunteers are needed to fill open slots.
- President Cherry announced that the Michelo Partnership raised almost \$500 at the District Conference
- Ed Shahin reminded the club that August 18th is End Polio Day at Nats Park (during a night game vs. the NY Mets). Vance Zavela added that the End Polio promotion will run all season long - anyone purchasing Nats tickets and using "End Polio" as a promo code will generate a \$5 donation for Rotary's Polio eradication efforts.
- Visiting Rotarian David Danner informed the club of a raffle being run by the Tyson's club for a week's stay in a

- condo in Spain and \$1000 towards airfare. Entry costs \$25. A raffle winner will be drawn at the upcoming Tyson's Wine Tasting Fundraiser.
- Jan Auerbach announced changes to the club's process for making grants. For the 2012-13 Rotary year, the club's grant committee will seek to involve all club members in funding decisions and require that all supported projects have a champion among the club membership. All funding requests are required to come via proposal; no automatic renewals of prior year fundings will be granted. The Foundation Board affirmed that, given the great social need both locally and internationally, the Foundation's general funds will not be allocated towards arts projects in the future, though individuals are invited to earmark donations specifically for such projects if desired. Funding proposals are due to Kathy Martin, Service Chair for 2012-2013, by July 1st, 2012. All submitted proposals will be summarized and distributed to club members for review. On July 31st, all club members will vote regarding what projects to fund next year, the results of the vote will be provided to the grants committee as an input in making allocation decisions. Volunteer (non-financial) opportunities to contribute will remain available for all organizations. Jan will electronically distribute copies of the strategic plan for 2012-13 and grant approval forms.
- **President Cherry** announced a new campaign focused on increasing our club's annual giving per capita. Historically, per capita giving figures have been: '09-'10: \$838; '10-'11: \$506; '11-'12 is currently at \$300.
