Obie O'Bryan introduced Jackie Knee, a former Mr. America and renowned body builder. Mr. Knee said there are three forms of weight training: weight lifting, power lifting, and body building. People get into shape through food and exercise. It is not the weight that builds the body, but it is the way you use it. Exercise breaks muscle down, and rest builds it back up. People who exercise correctly are getting older but their body is getting stronger; they have no bone loss or lessened body movement. He said narcissism is good: it will drive you to see results. He could not answer a question about the appropriate frequency of exercise because the answer depends too much on the individual. He said the trick is to learn how to work specific muscles. Children should not start weight training until they are 16 or 18, and then only with a trainer who knows what he/she is doing.
