The presentation will highlight the importance of recording the stories and traditions of individuals, and discuss how technology is making the preservation of these stories both exciting and easy. We'll also present some tips on discovering information on one's family through genealogical research. It will be a fun, interactive presentation, with plenty of audience participation and time for Q&A. The presentation will be led by David Adelman, the founder and CEO of Reel Tributes. **David Adelman** is the Founder and CEO of Reel Tributes, the premier producer of high-end personal history documentaries. He founded Reel Tributes after his grandmother passed away, and his mom made an amazing film about their family. Prior to founding Reel Tributes, David received his Masters in Business Administration from the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School, where he majored in Entrepreneurial Management. David graduated as a Palmer Scholar (top 5% of his graduating class) and was selected as Wharton's McGowan Fellow. He serves on the advisory board of Boston International, a nonprofit he cofounded.

Before Wharton, David was an associate with Charlesbank Capital Partners, a middle-market private equity firm in Boston. He also worked for the management consulting firm Bain & Company, advising clients in Los Angeles, Australia, and India. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Government, cum laude, from Harvard University, and grew up in Israel where he was the Israeli junior national golf champion. He now lives in Washington, DC with his wife Melissa, and enjoys playing golf and traveling in his (minimal) spare time. David is a member of the prestigious Young Entrepreneur Council and has been featured in Forbes, FOX News, Modern Luxury, and several other publications. His father has been a Rotarian for 34 years and David was honored as a Paul Harris Fellow.
