## Sept 20 Speakers-Lynn Heinrichs, Steve Swift & Todd Dempsey

**Treasurer, Lynn Heinrichs** distributed copies of a simplified operating budget for the year. She noted that dues and meals fees pay administrative expenses, but that fundraising is necessary to support service projects. She said the scanners that are now being used for attendance save time for the Sergeant-at-Arms, the Secretary, and the Treasurer, all of whom have a role in recording and reporting attendance. She showed members how to review their attendance and financial records on the web site, but said that members had to notify Celia or herself if there was an error in the attendance record. Members themselves can't make the correction directly on the web site. Doug Megill suggested that the bar code be placed on the back of our membership cards so that, when we go to another club for a makeup, that record can go directly into the computer. Michael DeRose received clarification that attendance at any Rotarian function qualifies for makeup for attendance but only submission of a receipt from another club qualifies for a meal credit.

**Service Committee Chair, Steve Swift** reported that there were 27 service project funding requests. Eight which were time-sensitive (Artfest, Wounded Warriors, Falls Church-McLean Children's Center, Stop Hunger Now, Rotary Youth Leadership Academy, Michelo, Langley Residential Support Services, and Homestretch) received a total of \$6,330. The deferred funding list totals \$46,140; how much of it can be funded depends on how much money the club raises.
