Chef Bonita Woods spoke on healthy eating, especially in schools. Chef Woods has worked as a top chef, but now focuses on battling especially childhood obesity through her institute and in the schools. She has found that school kids, especially teens, care deeply about their appearance and respond well to instruction on healthier eating. Her Bonita Woods Wellness Institute does outreach in Fairfax, going to libraries, for example, to meet with immigrant families on nutrition. Her programs bridge the large cultural gaps of such families and provide instruction on basic cooking in the US. She has also bought a mobile food truck to demonstrate a new gluten-free menu. Incorporating healthful foods into our lives and keeping our food intake in balance is difficult in the DC area. To do this, she emphasizes looking at the USDA "Food Plate" for guidance: fruits/vegetables, whole grains, protein and (optional) dairy. Using this guide can help keep our meals in excellent balance.
