Program - February 12 by Rick Neldon

Our speakers last week were Bailey Hopple and Ben Kelahan from the JBG Companies who are developing the area at 6862 Elm Street in downtown McLean. This site is basically the big parking lot across the street from MARS on Elm Street. The development will include mixed use of residential and shopping areas along Elm Street. The residential use will include up to 240 units which will be mostly rental, but some could be condominiums. Residential units will be 5 or 6 stories tall depending on land elevation. Architectural design will be mostly neo-classical or Jeffersonian. Plans include a central plaza, a short nature trail, and active recreation space. The new Fairfax Connector bus from Tyson's metro stations will have a stop at the property. JBG is currently working with the county regarding traffic issues. Affordable housing will be about 12½ percent of the development. This was an interesting presentation about the future development of our downtown area.
