Mr. Gene Poteat is a retired senior Central Intelligence Agency executive who was awarded the CIA's Intelligence Medal of Merit and the National Reconnaissance Office Meritorious Civilian Award. He is President of AFIO (Association of Former Intelligence Officers), and previously served on the Board of Advisors of the International Spy Museum. In addition, he serves as a Member of the Advisory Board of Intellaine, LLP, a U.S. defense and risk engineering firm located in Arlington, Virginia.
