Program – March 5 by Pamela Danner

Brian Shea, past GSE fellow in Jamaica sponsored by McLean Club, was our speaker about his 18 months as USAid Director for Regional Platform South Afghanistan. He described Southern Afghanistan as predominantly an agricultural economy that is the breadbasket of Afghanistan. It is very dry in the summer and the main crops are almonds, grapes, pomegranates, and poppies. He worked on interagency cooperation and worked with the District Support Team working with the Province Governor and with the US military. He used a process oriented approach to identify key stakeholders and address grievances, monitor and evaluate programs, and work with local media to increase communication. He was seeking community buy-in to the rule of law. Prior to joining USAid, he worked with the nonprofit organization, Peace Players International.
