This was a continuation of his April 13 presentation. He listed the 12 tax audit red flags: 1) you have foreign assets, 2) your ex wants revenge, 3) your return has too many zeroes, 4) you have a home office, 5) you forgot some income, 6) you claim fishy deductions, 7) you're rich, 8) you make public statements that conflict with what you report, 9) you do a lot of work-related driving, 10) you exaggerate donations, 11) you own a money-losing business, and 12) you have a shady tax preparer. Bob also talked about identity theft. If you filed your return over a month ago and have not yet received your refund, you may be the victim of identity theft. If so, file Form 14039 - IRS Identity Theft Affidavit form.
