Darlene Williamson, founder and Executive Director of the Stroke Comeback Center, spoke about "Signs and Recovery from a Stroke." The Stroke Comeback Center is a community-based non-profit organization that provides programs for families in a supportive, caring environment. It is the only center of its kind in the Washington, DC area.

Miss Williamson defined a stroke as an interruption in the supply of blood to the brain for a certain period of time, with time loss effecting brain loss. We learned in the U.S. there is one stroke every 45 seconds, accounting for nearly 800,000 Americans per year. There are 6 ½ million people living with stroke, and it is the 3rd leading cause of death in the U.S. 60% of women are affected by stroke, versus 40% of men. 40% of people in a recent survey could not identify a single symptom of stroke, but Miss Williamson helped educate us: trouble with walking, speaking, or understanding, paralysis or numbness of the face, arm, or leg, trouble with seeing in one or both eyes, and/or a sudden, severe headache which may be accompanied by vomiting, dizziness, or altered consciousness.
