Program – September 11, 2012 by William Reed

Doug Potts, Vice-Chair of the McLean Revitalization Corporation, explained the work now starting in downtown McLean which is centered at the intersection of Chain Bridge Rd. and Old Dominion. The earthwork we see in front of the Chicken Out and BP station is to put in duct banks into which Dominion Power is to pull power lines. This is the first step in placing the utilities underground in an area roughly from where they have started to an equivalent distance up Chain Bridge on the other side of Old Dominion and on Old Dominion from just below the Shell Station to about the McDonalds. Also, there will be pedestrian islands placed in Old Dominion north of the Chain Bridge intersection and in front of the McLean Square shopping center. In addition, traffic lights will be resynchronized to be more friendly to pedestrians.
