Program – August 13, 2013 – by Jan Auerbach

Bob Hahne introduced District Governor Juanita Cawley, a graduate of colleges in New York, Oklahoma, and Virginia. She is a former teacher of hearing impaired students in Hampton and West Point, VA. She was Assistant Superintendent of Schools in West Point before she retired in 2012. She has held numerous leadership positions with District 7610 and is a major financial contributor to RI.

Juanita began her talk by commending McLean for doing so much giving, service, and fellowship. She said meeting with our board before the lunch meeting was a “wow factor.” She appreciated meeting **Dale Lazar** at the 2012 installation dinner so that she knew him for the entire year she was planning her year as Governor. She explained the RI President Ron Burton challenged all 520 District Governors worldwide to contribute to the RI Foundation before they assumed office and, for the first time, all of them did. He then challenged District Governors to have all their district presidents make the same commitment before their term started. All 54 presidents in District 7610 met that challenge. Juanita presented Dale with a certificate in honor of his donation.

RI’s theme this year is “Engage Rotary, Change Lives.” Juanita said that surveys show the main reasons for joining Rotary are service and fellowship. Juanita joined Rotary when her West Point Superintendent told her that, because she was new to their small town, she needed to join a service organization. She chose Rotary. She feels she found her passion this year when she attended a Peace Fellow conference at Duke/UNC with this year’s District 7610 Peace Fellow. She was very impressed with the important work Peace Fellows do once they complete their Master’s Degree in Peace and Conflict Resolution. She noted that, during periods of armed conflict, basic needs such as
