Francine Proulx is an appraiser/consultant/broker, and President of "Art/Antiques Information Resource, LLC." Miss Proulx provided tips for working with an appraiser accredited or certified by the American Society of Appraisers (ASA) or the International Society of Appraisers (ISA):

- 1) Know when to get something appraised
- 2) Get a written appraisal to document an item's value
- 3) Don't forget your valuable art, antiques, and decorative arts when planning your estate
- 4) Hire a qualified appraiser at www.appraisers.org or www.isa-appraisers.org. Don't use an appraiser who offers to buy the item or charges % of value.

Tell appraiser anything you know about the item's origin. You should receive a written report describing the item, the reasons for its valuation, and which type of value was done: replacement value, fair market value, or market value.
