Jan Auerbach gave her "End of Year Report"

Under project funding, the Club contributed \$27,450 to 14 different projects both local and international.

For service project fundraising, the Club raised over \$22,000 from 5 different sources-Monte Carlo Night and the Chocolate Festival being the biggest two.

Club Members contributed \$23,800 to Rotary International Foundation and \$5,100 to the McLean Rotary Club Foundation and an additional \$9,400 was contributed by members in pass the hat format for specific causes.

Besides funds contributed, Members volunteered in 13 different service project efforts. Members enjoyed each other's Fellowship in a variety of ways; such as the End Polio Game at Nationals Park, monthly happy hours, a party at Jan's house, and time at the beginning of each meeting to socialize.

Our current membership is 61 with 5 new members.

For our Club Budget, our Club ended the year with an \$8,000 surplus due to Lynn printing the newsletter in her office, Bob Frank waiving accounting fees for our 990 filing, and \$1900 in meal charges from visiting Rotarians and guests.

Changes that Jan instituted for this year were: champions required for project funding, multi-voting to obtain member input on projects to be funded, recitation of the Four Way Test at meetings, lunch menu more varied and healthy, and member vote to continue participation in Monte Carlo Night.

She announced the results of the Satisfaction Survey as the Members want:

- -More and varied fellowship
- -More fun at meetings

They also provided suggestions regarding speakers which will be incorporated in the coming year.

Jan then thanked all the member volunteers and gave out certificates of appreciation and

awards.

She presented certificates of 100% attendance, a certificate of appreciation to the McLean High School Interact Club, a certificate of appreciation to our caterer Jimmy, and a service above self award each to Bob Koenig for scheduling interesting speakers and to Bill Reed for preparing the weekly newsletter. Finally, she announced that Glenn Yarborough is the recipient of the McLean Rotarian of the Year Award as the ultimate "yes, I will do it" person.
