Program - August 5, 2014

Lynn Heinrichs introduced **Ben Boxer**, a representative of the Fairfax County (FC) Department of Public Works and Environmental Services. Mr. Boxer noted that FC defines trash as a resource since processing of waste can benefit the community. FC processes 1 million tons of waste yearly. Each person in the county generates 2000 lbs. of trash per year. He explained the trash disposal and recycling services for FC that are provided by the I-66 Transfer Station on West Ox Road in Fairfax and at the I-95 Landfill and Energy Resource Recovery complex in Lorton. He also described the county's hazardous waste program and its curbside recycling services. Mr. Boxer provided four reasons for recycling: to 1) preserve natural resources, 2) reduce greenhouse gas emissions, 3) conserve energy, and 4) preserve space in waste management systems for non-recyclable trash. He stressed the importance of reducing waste and reusing items, with recycling efforts beginning in the home. On August 16 there will be a document shredding event at Cooper Middle School in McLean. Electronics can now be recycled daily at the I-66 Transfer Station. For more information: contact www.fc.gov/recycling or call 703-324-5230.
