RICHARD B. STOREY, 7610 District Governor, was our speaker.

He is DC native and has been a Rotarian since 1998. He found Rotary after pursuing a lifelong desire to heed his father's advice repeated at Saturday night dinners to lead a life of service to others. In Junior High School he was in Demolay, a service club. In college he joined Alpha Phi Omega, fraternity, which was dedicated to service. After graduation Richard worked as Boy Scout district executive for 2 years, then became membership director of the National Crushed Stone Assn. In the early 70's he became CEO of the Pennsylvania Restaurant Association, where he succeeded in gaining weight. He next became CEO of the International Military Club Executives' Association. When he later became Chairman of the Board of the Blue Ridge Speech and Hearing Center in Leesburg, he was introduced to Rotary and became immersed in Rotary service, satisfying the need his father instilled in him to be of service to others.

Richard's key focus during his term will be increasing club membership.
