Club Leadership Training - Breakout Sessions

A-1 Finding Service Projects: Panel discussion. Where should you look for meaningful local service projects? What kind of community connections should you foster? What are examples of some successful local projects? Hear the experts.

A-2 Growing Membership: Panel Discussion. Hear from fellow Rotarians tried and effective methods for attracting new members. All clubs need to grow. This session is for Membership chairs as well as all club leadership.

A-3 Youth Opportunities: Learn more about Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) and Youth Exchange. What are these programs? How will your club benefit? What are the steps necessary for you to participate?

A-4 Demystifying Global Scholarships & Peace Fellows: These Rotary programs are fantastic opportunities for college graduates to make a difference in the world. What is a club's role in supporting applicants? How can we better inform our communities about these opportunities so that we attract qualified people?

A-5 DACdb (District And Club database) Training: Learn the features and advantages of using DACdb to manage your club and member information. This session is for secretaries, presidents, presidents-elect and committee chairs. With the right selections, you can enter information here and it will exchange with Rotary's database.

B-1 Service Projects – Best Practices: Panel Discussion. From the grant application to the completion of a project – know the tips for success.

B-2 Be A Vibrant Club: Take your club from good to great. Learn ways to revitalize your club and better engage new and established members. This session is for presidents, presidents-elect, and club service chairs and all club leadership.

B-3 Interact Clubs – Panel: Hear Interactors and past Interactors (now Rotaractors and/or Rotarians) on the importance of membership for them, why they choose to be part of Rotary, and how to influence their peers. Hear ways to improve the exchange between an Interact Club and its sponsoring Rotary Club. This session is for Rotarians and Interactors.

B-4 Rotaract Clubs – Panel: Hear Rotaractors and past Rotaractors (now Rotarians) on the importance of membership for them, why they choose to be part of Rotary, and how to influence their peers. Hear ways to improve the exchange between a Rotaract Club and its sponsoring Rotary Club. This session is for Rotarians and Rotaractors.

B-5 Secretary Training: Know what your responsibilities are, the resources for keeping your membership up to date, and taking successful meeting minutes. Being in attendance is no longer an RI requirement but taking and reporting your club's attendance still is. Learn how and why.

C-1 Strategic Planning: Rotary Clubs with a plan are stronger than those without.

Rotary International has updated its strategic plan. Learn about strategic planning for your club. If you have a plan already, dust it off and align it to the RI plan.

C-2 Public Image and Public Relations: By increasing the public's understanding of Rotary, we're strengthening our ability to make an impact in communities around the world. This session is for PI/PR chairs and all club leadership.

C-3 – Interact 101: What makes a successful Interact Club? Learn ways to organize your club, identify service projects, promote club successes, and attract potential members. This session is for the leadership of Interact Clubs.

C-4 Rotaract 101: What makes a successful Rotaract Club? Learn ways to organize your club, identify service projects, promote club successes, and attract potential members. This session is for leadership of Rotaract clubs.

C-5 – Treasurer Training: Learn the necessary steps to provide your club with meaningful records and reports backed up documentation. What do you know about club insurance? What does the RI insurance policy cover and what's not covered? Learn about the steps to ensure that your club's liability is at a minimum. The session is for all club leadership.
