- 12:30 Results and awards
- 12:45 Boxed luncheon – Student plus 4 (extras are \$12 each)
- 1:00-2:00 Lunch and learn – may want to enjoy and eat lunch

Remember that every Rotarian in attendance will vote (sorry your family and friends will not be allowed to vote). You will be allowed to sit with your friends and family and watch the competition.

After the competition, there will be a panel discussion that you can watch. During that time, a panel discussion will take place showcasing the power of partnership with Rotary, including club-community partnerships and club-to-club partnerships

The first place winner will receive \$1,500.00, second place receives \$1,000.00, third place \$750.00 and fourth place \$500.00.
