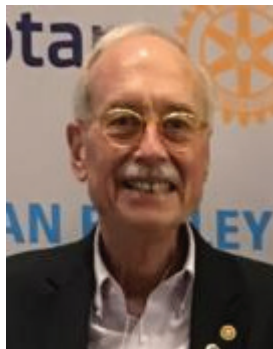


IN MEMORIAM ROBERT SMITH
