CAREER FAIR AT COLUMBIA HEIGHTS EDUCATIONAL CAMPUS

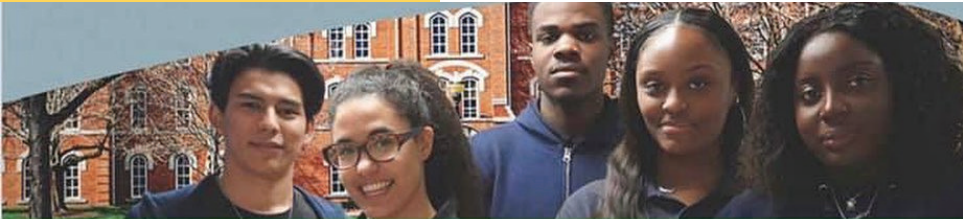
