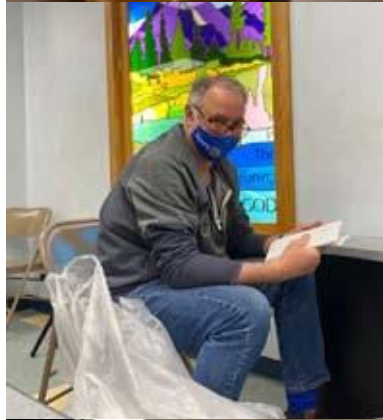

Carolyn Fredericks, executive director of Dover's Modern Maturity Center and a long-time advocate for older adults, addressed Dover Capital City Rotary Club at its Thursday, January 13, luncheon meeting. Ms. Fredericks has been actively involved with the Modern Maturity Center since 1972 beginning as a volunteer visiting shut-ins, later becoming coordinator of social services for nutrition. In 1981, she became Deputy Director and in 2001 was named executive director.

During her tenure as executive director, she has overseen three capital campaigns for major building expansions that included a medical arts building, a new adult day services facility and a kitchen expansion that transformed the facility into a multi-million-dollar corporation and one of the leading providers of aging services in the state. A new Early Memory Loss program is the first of its kind in Delaware.

Ms. Fredericks is well-known among state and federal legislators for her knowledge and understanding of aging issues and her passion for feeding and serving older adults.

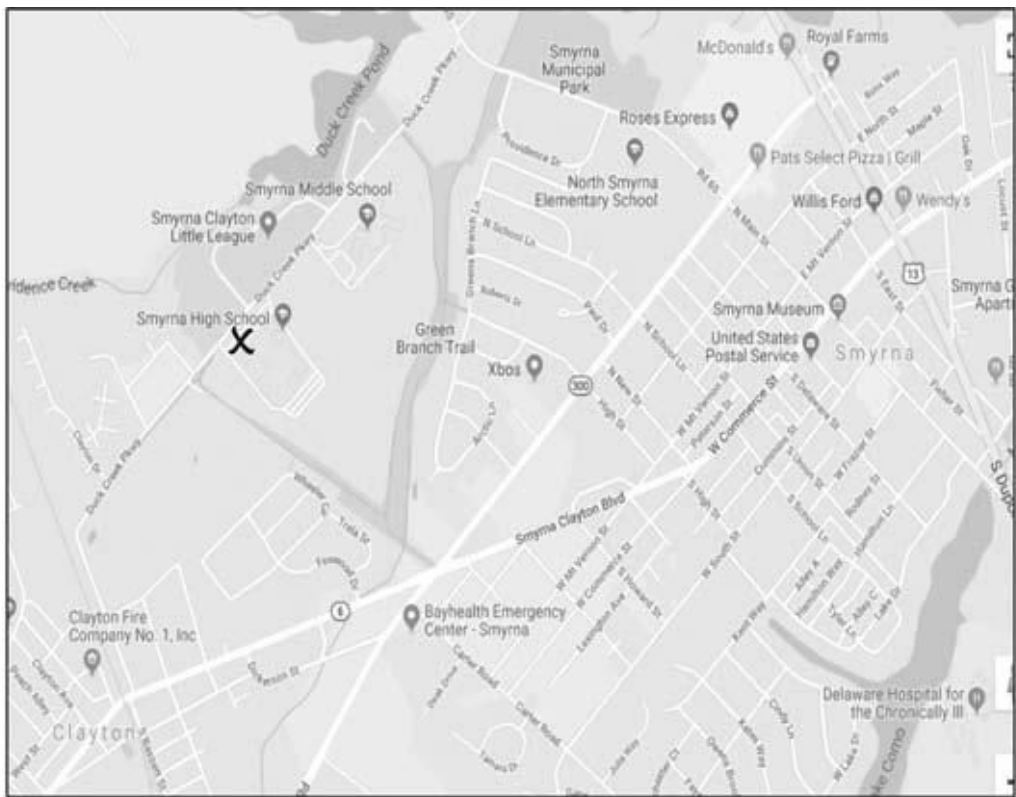
