Program of July 22:

Kurt Wehberg Beebe—Robotic Surgery

On July 22, Dr. Kurt Wehberg of Beebe Hospital, spoke to Rotary about its one year - old Center for Robotic Surgery. Wehberg, who began the robotic program at Peninsula Medical Center in Salisbury, comes to Beebe after 27 years of work in open heart surgery, and more recently, robotic surgery.

The trend to technology is of benefit to both patients and the health care system. For patients, as opposed to open procedures which require invasive cutting of the body, robotics allows the attending physician to make smaller incisions which results in lower rates of infection; surgical teams operate for a shorter period of time because the robotic system is able to move in ways that cannot be duplicated by the human hand; and there is less need for pain medications which reduces the likelihood of addiction to opioids. Recovery periods are much shorter; hospital stays can be reduced from 7 - 8 days to as little as one day, thus saving Beebe about \$13,000 per case, or over \$130,000 per month.

Not every patient is the right candidate for robotically assisted procedures, and so the Beebe surgical teams are still performing traditional open surgery. But the trend is obvious - in 2019, 150 operations were performed with the assistance of robots versus six relying on the traditional method.

Dr. Wehberg and his colleagues are committed to being a leader in providing patients with minimally invasive treatments that allow them to recover more quickly and a return to enjoyment of their lives.
