Your high school student will travel to another country and live with a host family for one month, and then a student from that host family will come back with your son or daughter to be hosted in the US for one month. A one-year program host commits to hosting a student from another country for 3-6 months. To gain a better understanding of the culture, study abroad students will live with at least two, preferably three host families during the school year. This is a great way for you and your family to share all there is to love about Western North Carolina and to learn about more about another culture.
