## PROCESS FOR BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE ROTARY CLUB OF ASHEVILLE -BILTMORE

- If not already familiar with Rotary, visit <u>www.rotary.org</u> to learn about Rotary International and its worldwide activities. A good understanding of club values and activities can be found at <u>www.asheville-biltmorerotary.org</u>. Review the *Rotary Club of Asheville-Biltmore Membership Expectations* document.
- The club treasurer will bill you the \$100 initiation fee (this fee is waived for persons who have held Rotary membership in other clubs). Going forward, fees are billed on a quarterly basis.
- 3. Some weeks after being inducted into membership you will be scheduled to give a 3-5 minute new member talk to the club. After telling the club about your life experiences, having chosen a committee to join, and having completed a first service project, you will be given your permanent, blue membership badge to replace the red badge.
- 4. At various times during the year the club's programs will further educate and orient you to the operations of Rotary International and the club.
