

PROCESS FOR BECOMING A MEMBER OF
THE ROTARY CLUB
OF ASHEVILLE -BILTMORE

1. If not already familiar with Rotary, visit www.rotary.org to learn about Rotary International and its worldwide activities. A good understanding of club values and activities can be found at www.asheville-biltmorerotary.org. Review the *Rotary Club of Asheville-Biltmore Membership Expectations* document.
2. The club treasurer will bill you the \$100 initiation fee (this fee is waived for persons who have held Rotary membership in other clubs). Going forward, fees are billed on a quarterly basis.
3. Some weeks after being inducted into membership you will be scheduled to give a 3-5 minute new member talk to the club. After telling the club about your life experiences, having chosen a committee to join, and having completed a first service project, you will be given your permanent, blue membership badge to replace the red badge.
4. At various times during the year the club's programs will further educate and orient you to the operations of Rotary International and the club.
