

DACdb Login Instructions

Sooo...you've heard about the new District and Club data base (DACdb) and you'd like to log on to to learn more about it.

Actually, logging on to DACdb is relatively painless, but there are some hoops you may need to negotiate. After Googling or using your favorite browser to look up DACdb and the logon button, the first issue you may confront is that of your Username. For most, it's your email address. However, your email address on file may be an old one. If that's what appears to be case (you'll know after being told it won't let you in), go out of the system and go to www.hendersonvillerotary.com. Scroll down under Members to Bob Sodestrom's name and email him, asking for the email the District has on file for you. After Bob provides you with that information, try looking up DACdb again.

The next hurdle is your password. That information is located on the address label of your Rotarian Magazine contained within the nine digit number just above your name. Strip away the first and last digits and type your password using the middle seven. Our club number, which is the next block to fill, is 6019.
