4. Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned?

### Declaration of Rotarians In Business and Professions

**As a Rotarian engaged in a business or profession, I am expected to:**

- Consider my vocation to be another opportunity to serve;
- Be faithful to the letter and to the spirit of the ethical codes of my vocation, to the laws of my country, and to the standards of my community;
- Do all in my power to dignify my vocation and to promote the highest ethical standards in my chosen vocation;
- Be fair to my employer, employees, associates, competitors, customers, the public and all those with whom I have a business or professional relationship;
- Recognize the honor and respect due to all occupations which are useful to society;
- Offer my vocational talents to provide opportunities for young people, to work for the relief of the special needs of others, and to improve the quality of life in my community;
- Adhere to honesty in my advertising and in all representations to the public concerning my business or profession;
- Neither seek from nor grant to a fellow Rotarian a privilege or advantage not normally accorded others in a business or professional relationship.

## Object of Rotary

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

**First:** The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

**Second:** High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

**Third:** The application of the ideal of service in every Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;

**Fourth:** The advancement of international understanding, goodwill and peace, through a world fellowship of business and professional Rotarians united in the ideal of service.

## Avenues of Service

Based on the Object of Rotary, the [Avenues of Service](#) are Rotary's philosophical cornerstone and the foundation on which club activity is based:

- **Club Service** focuses on strengthening fellowship and ensuring the effective functioning of the club.
- **Vocational Service** encourages Rotarians to serve others through their vocations and to practice high ethical standards.
- **Community Service** covers the projects and activities the club undertakes to improve life in its community.
- **International Service** encompasses actions taken to expand Rotary's humanitarian reach around the globe and to promote world understanding and peace.
- **New Generations Service** recognizes the positive change implemented by youth and young adults through leadership development activities, service projects, and exchange programs.



## Reach Within to Embrace Humanity

In 2011-12, I ask Rotarians to *Reach Within to Embrace Humanity*. I ask you to look within yourselves, to understand that all of humanity has the same dreams, similar hopes, the same aspirations and similar problems. Whoever we are and wherever we live, each of us yearns for the same peace and contentment and for the same fulfillment in our daily lives. What we work to bring to others, we must first find within ourselves because what we wish for ourselves is what others wish for themselves as well.

Before talking globally about peace, we need first to start with ourselves and then work outward. First, we find our own peace, and then work to establish peace in our homes and our families and our communities. We cannot work to build peace in the world without first building it in our own homes; if we are to create peace, friendship, and tolerance on a global scale, we must first practice it in our own neighborhoods. When we have peace in ourselves, we have peace in our home; when there is peace in our home, we have peace that we can share with others. As we find joy and satisfaction in being with the people we love and care about, we are able to care for others as well.

I believe that if you strengthen yourself, you strengthen those who share your life and your home. Once you have a strong family, you have a strong base on which to build. Those who have that inner strength can work together better to serve humanity, and that is what we do in Rotary.

In the year ahead, we will have three emphases in our Rotary service: to strengthen our family, to continue what we do best, and to change whatever needs to be changed.

Our first emphasis in this Rotary year will be the *family*. The family is where everything begins: All our service, everything we wish to achieve in our world, begins here. The mother and the child are at the core of every family; when we begin there, we can carry our work forward through individual lives and throughout the community.

Our second emphasis will be on *continuity*, on finding the things that we do well and taking them to the next level. Each of us has found success in Rotary service, and we should build on those successes, expand on them, so that we can help even more people in the future. We must continue our work for cleaner and safer water, mitigating disease and illness, spreading literacy, working with and for the new generation, and striving for peace.


At the same time, we also know that there are things we could be doing better and things which we should be changing. We must have the courage to see these, to identify them, and to work to make the changes we need to make.

Mohandas Gandhi said, "You must be the change you wish to see in the world." In Rotary, we endeavor to live ethically and honestly, to share friendship and goodwill, to see the true worth of every human being. We are not interested in the lowest common denominator, for Rotary is anything but common and Rotarians are uncommon people. That is why we work to elevate ourselves and, thereby, to elevate the world.

All of us in Rotary are looking to change the world, for why else would we be Rotarians? We believe that our world can be happier, healthier, and more peaceful. We believe that the future can and will be better than the past. We are idealists, and we bring our ideals to life through our Rotary service.

And so, our third emphasis in 2011-12 will be *change*, and we start by being the change we wish to see in the world. If we wish for peace, we start by living in peace ourselves, in our homes and in our communities. If we wish for an end to polio or to any other disease in the world, if we wish environmental degradation to stop, if we wish to reduce child mortality, to spread literacy or to prevent hunger, we must be the instrument of that change and recognize that it must start within each of us.

Let us *Reach Within to Embrace Humanity*. And in peace, harmony, and friendship, let us bring change and a more joyful future for us all.



# Rotary International President 2011-2012 Kalyan Banerjee

Kalyan Banerjee is chair of United Phosphorus, Bangladesh, and a director of United Phosphorus Ltd., one of the largest manufacturers of agrochemicals in India, and Uniphos Agro Industries Ltd. Born in Kolkata in 1942, he earned a degree in chemical engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur, in 1964. He is a resident of Vapi, Gujarat, where he has contributed significantly to its development as one of the largest industrial estates in India, helping to provide infrastructure for health care and education.

Banerjee has been a member of the Rotary Club of Vapi since 1972. He served as club president in 1975-76 and district governor in 1980-81. He began his international service to Rotary in 1995, with his appointment to the RI Board of Directors. He has gone on to serve as general coordinator of the Poverty and Hunger Alleviation Task Force (1997-98), trustee of The Rotary Foundation (2001-05), and chair of the Southeast Asia PolioPlus Committee (2009-10). He has served on numerous other committees, including the International PolioPlus Committee (2008-09), Reach Out to Africa Ad-Hoc Executive Committee (2009-10), Leadership Development and Training Committee (2009-10), Permanent Fund Committee for India (2008-09), and the Child Mortality Emphasis Coordinating Team (2008-09).

Banerjee is also active in many other organizations, including the American Chemical Society, Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers, and the Senate of the Vishva-Bharati University. He has served twice as president of Vapi Industries Association and is a past chair of the Gujarat Council of the Confederation of Indian Industry. In addition, he is a trustee for the Jai Research Foundation.

Kalyan Banerjee is married to Binota, a social worker, and they have two children and four grandchildren.

## PAUL P. HARRIS FOUNDER OF ROTARY (1868-1947)



Born in Racine, Wisconsin, on April 19, 1868, Paul was the second of six children. At age three, he moved to Wallingford, Vermont, where he grew up in the care of his paternal grandparents. He married Jean Thomson

Harris

received an LL.B. from the University of Iowa and was awarded an honorary law degree from the University of Vermont.

In 1896, Paul went to Chicago to practice law. After meeting several tradesmen one evening during an after dinner stroll with a friend, he

formulated the idea of fellowship composed of businessmen from different occupations without restrictions of politics or religion. On February 23, 1905, Paul formed the first club with three other businessmen: Silvester Schiele, Gustavus Loehr and Hiram Shorey. Paul named the new club “Rotary” because members met in rotation at their various places of business.

The second Rotary Club was founded in 1908 in San Francisco. The National Association of Rotary clubs was organized in 1910, and the name was changed to the International Association of Rotary Clubs in 1912 when clubs were formed in Canada and Great Britain. In 1922, it was shortened to Rotary International. Paul Harris served as the first president of both organizations. Eleven years later, the “Four Way Test” was adopted.

Paul Harris was prominent in other civic and professional work. He was recognized for his work as the first chairman of the board of the National Easter Seal Society For Crippled Children. His leadership was evident in the legal profession both locally and internationally, and he was recognized by the Boy Scouts of America and the governments of Brazil, Chile, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, France and Peru for his service to youth.

Upon his death on January 27, 1947, his dream had grown from an informal meeting of four friends to an international organization of more than 33,000 clubs. Today, there are more than 1.2 million Rotarians in 200 countries around the world.

# HISTORY OF ROTARY IN NORTH CAROLINA

North Carolina's first Rotary club was formed in Raleigh on August 1, 1914, becoming the 124th Rotary club in the world. Nearly all of the North Carolina clubs are descendants of the Raleigh, Wilmington or Richmond, Virginia, clubs.

Rotary began organizing into districts (first called divisions) in 1912. North Carolina's earliest clubs (1915-18) were in District 4, which included the south-eastern part of the United States south of Washington, D. C. and Maryland.

In 1918, the Rotary Clubs of Virginia, North Carolina and South Carolina were grouped together to form District 7. Governors from North Carolina serving District 7 were: Howard E. Ronthaler, Winston-Salem (1918-19); Roger W. Davis, Charlotte (1919-20); and Roger Moore, Wilmington (1922-23)

In 1923, North Carolina and Virginia were reorganized into District 37 and, by 1926, the number of clubs organized in North Carolina was sufficient to form a district within the state, creating District 57.

Enough clubs existed in the piedmont and eastern areas of North Carolina in 1937 to form two districts. By 1946, North Carolina was divided into four districts and today has six.

There have been three Rotarians from North Carolina who came up through the ranks to become President of Rotary International. First was Eugene Newson, from Durham N.C. in 1929-1930, followed by Charles G.(Buzz) Tennent, from Ashville, N.C. in 1957-1958.

In 1967, Luther H. Hodges became president of Rotary International. Hodges was governor of North Carolina from 1954 to 1960, and served as Secretary of Commerce from 1961 to 1965. His Rotary theme for 1967-68 was "Make Your Rotary Membership Effective."

District 7680 was established July 1, 1992 with 2,750 Rotarians and 39 clubs, 29 from District 7670 and 10 from District 7690. Norman W. Schul, from Charlotte North, served as the first District Governor (1992-93).

District 7680 is noted for its support of The Rotary Foundation, its programs for youth and as "the Birthplace of Rotaract" with the founding of the first Rotaract Club at UNC-Charlotte on March 13, 1968, by the Charlotte North Rotary Club.

The Charlotte Rotary Club is the district's oldest club, chartered December 1, 1916, followed by Gastonia (January 1, 1920) and Salisbury (May 1, 1920).

At Rotary year-end 2008, there were 3,108 Rotarians in 52 clubs in the 14 counties which make up District 7680.



The reason District 7680's newly designated governor for 2011-2012 has gotten deeply involved in Rotary and community activities is cross-stitched and framed, hanging in his office, given him long ago by his sister.
