The annual **JOHN MUNN CLASSIC** is held in memory of John Clark Munn, Jr., longtime Rotarian. Instrumental in the founding of the Union West Rotary club in 1996, he served as the club's first president. An avid historian, he kept a diary of historical facts, which he shared each week during the club meeting.

Munn was born in Candor in 1936 and graduated from Wake Forest University in 1960 with a degree in political science. After college, he enlisted in the Army and served for 2 years in the Intelligence Corps during the Cuban missile crisis. He was a recipient of North Carolina's Order of the Long Leaf Pine, among the highest honors the governor can give to a North Carolina resident.

He also was past president of the National Association of County Managers.
