- Rotary is a worldwide organization of business and professional leaders that provides humanitarian service, encourages high ethical standards in all vocations, and helps build goodwill and peace in the world.
- Approximately 1.2 million Rotarians belong to more than 33,000 Rotary clubs located in 166 countries.
- The first Rotary club was founded in 1905. The name "Rotary" derived from the early practice of rotating meetings among members' offices.
- Rotary is now the largest and most influential civic club in the world
- The Rotary Motto: "Service Above Self"
- **Object of Rotary** is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:
  - The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service,
  - High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society,
  - The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life.
  - The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

  - Is it the Truth?
  - Is it Fair to All Concerned?
  - Will it be for Good Will and Better Friendships
  - Will it be Beneficial to All Concerned

### **3) What will be expected of me as a Rotary member?**

Mecklenburg County-South Rotary utilizes a “Red Badge” program to help new members get to know club members and Rotary International’s full scope of offerings. New members will wear a red name badge until they complete a list of tasks ranging from attending functions to recruiting new members. The Red Badge program is not meant to be an inhibitor to membership, but a tool to make sure that new members are known by tenured members and that they understand the true commitment of Rotary. An official Blue badge will be issued when the following tasks are completed:

- 1) Complete all of the following during provisional membership:
  - A) Maintain at least 50% attendance
  - B) Pay dues on time
- 2) Complete three Red Badge training meetings
- 3) Get involved by joining a committee
- 4) Bring at least one prospective member to a meeting
- 5) Attend a Meck-South board meeting
- 6) Attend a Rotary meeting at another Rotary club
- 7) Complete at least two of the following:
  - A) Attend a club social event
  - B) Participate in a club community service project
  - C) Participate in a District 7680 or Rotary International event
  - D) Complete an on-line make up
- 8) Conduct Health & Happiness and/or Prayer & Invocation at two meetings
- 9) Assist the Sergeant-at-Arms at two meetings

### **4) What should I expect from Rotary?**

- A great breakfast every week
- Meetings to end promptly at 8:30 every week
- To make lifelong friendships, and to have fun!
- To make contacts that will help your career
- A great program each week. Examples include:
  - An Olympic Gold Medal winner
  - Elected Officials: Mayor of Charlotte, NC Secretary of State
  - The President of a local large company
  - A former Panther’s quarterback
  - The Police Chief of Charlotte
  - Local TV personalities
  - The Director of Elon Homes for Children
  - A Program translated from Spanish to English
- Personal Growth and Development

## 5) Membership Application and Process:

1. Visit the club a few times: Breakfast is on the club for the first meeting. Subsequent visits are \$12.00 until membership is extended after which, meals are included in dues.
2. Review this New Member Packet and review the Rotary International web site at [www.rotary.org](http://www.rotary.org) and the Meck-South web site at [www.mecksouthrotary.org](http://www.mecksouthrotary.org) to familiarize yourself with Rotary and our club. (if you get a chance, read some of our history)
3. Fill out the enclosed membership application
4. Have a meeting with the Club's Membership Director Bill Woodruff to discuss your commitment to Rotary and what Rotary can do for you.
5. Your membership application is announced to the club at 2 weekly meetings. Club members have one week to raise any concerns regarding a potential new member's application.
6. Board members have a formal vote to induct all new members. (board meetings are 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of each month)
7. Membership is granted and announced in a formal presentation at a meeting (family and/or spouses are invited and encouraged to attend this meeting). A name badge is presented along with a New Member kit.
8. Pay your first quarter dues.
9. Get involved!
