Every year, Rotaract clubs must report a president or adviser through [My Rotary](#). To strengthen the Rotary-Rotaract connection, we encourage *all Rotaract clubs to report a Rotaract Adviser*, that is, a Rotarian, university faculty member, or community leader who supports the Rotaract club. The Rotaract president and the Rotaract adviser will receive all Rotaract program updates from Rotary.
